

List of the Marine Fish species of North Carolina - compiled 2018-04-27

This is a listing of the marine fish species that are known to occur or presumed to occur in North Carolina waters, based on A Field Guide to Coastal Fishes: from Maine to Texas, by Kells and Carpenter, 2011. The book lists species that are generally found from the intertidal zone to depths of about 660 feet (200 meters). Fishes that are predominantly found in freshwater, but do occur in low-salinity waters, are included in their book. Also included in their book are some deep-water species (deeper than 200 meters), but in general most deep-water species are not included. See this reference for additional criteria for inclusion or exclusion.

Kells and Carpenter (2011) give ranges of species in text form only, generally from the northern to the southern limits -- e.g., MA to FL, or NC to FL. In the latter example (NC to FL), it is clear that the species has been recorded in North Carolina; however, the NC Biodiversity Project can only infer that the species has been recorded in NC waters in the former example (MA [Massachusetts] to FL [Florida]). Thus, our website list might contain a few species that have not actually been recorded in NC waters; and conversely, might include a few strays that we have not included because of stated ranges that do not include NC, such as SC to FL.

The Kells and Carpenter book uses the family names and scientific names from Fishes of the World, 4th Edition, by Nelson. [This book is now in its 5th Edition (2016).] Kells and Carpenter use common names taken from Common and Scientific Names of Fishes from the United States, Canada, and Mexico, 6th Edition, published by the American Fisheries Society. [This list is now in its 7th Edition (2013).] Their book does not capitalize the family or group name in a common name (e.g., Red snapper); however, the family or group name is capitalized in the American Fisheries Society (AFS) list. Our website list follows the AFS and capitalizes each word in the common name.
