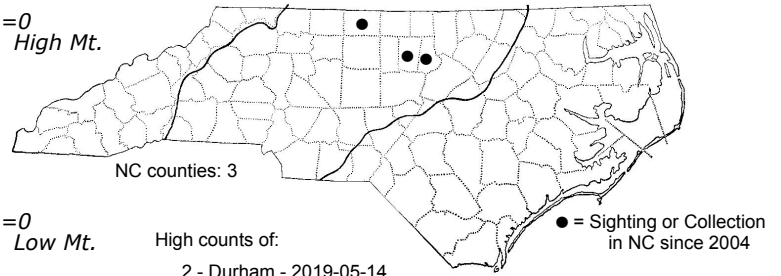
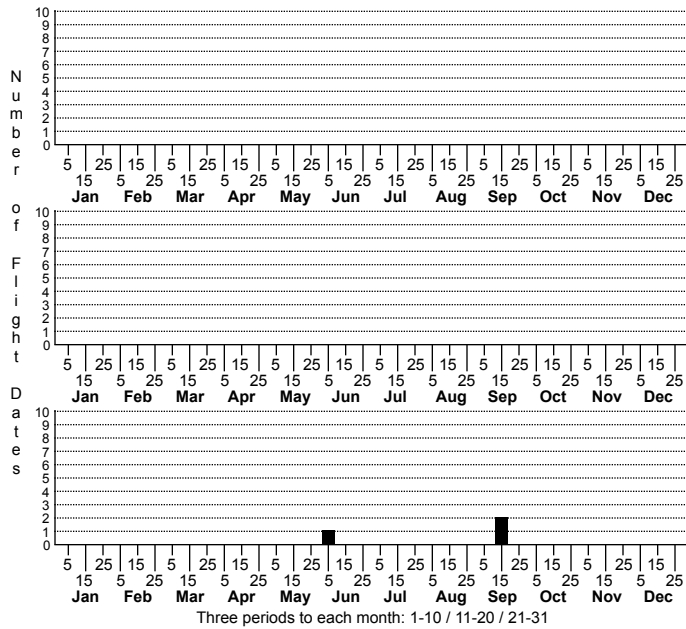


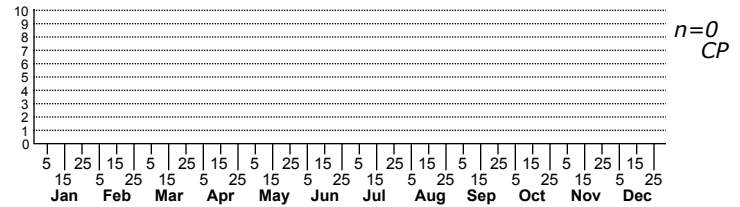

HABITAT:

FOOD: The larvae feed of several members of the Apiaceae, including Hairy-fruit Chervil (*Chaerophyllum tainturieri*), Canadian Honewort (*Cryptotaenia canadensis*), Yellow Pimpernel (*Taenidia integerrima*), Heartleaf Golden-Alexanders (*Zizia aptera*), Common Golden-Alexanders (*Z. aurea*); Eiseman 2019a).
