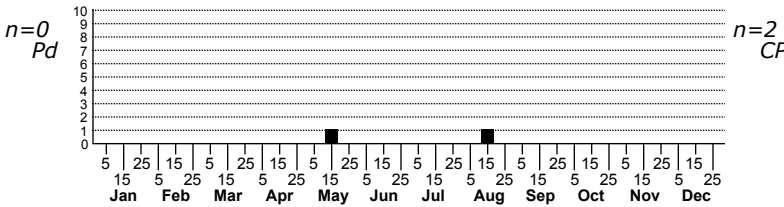
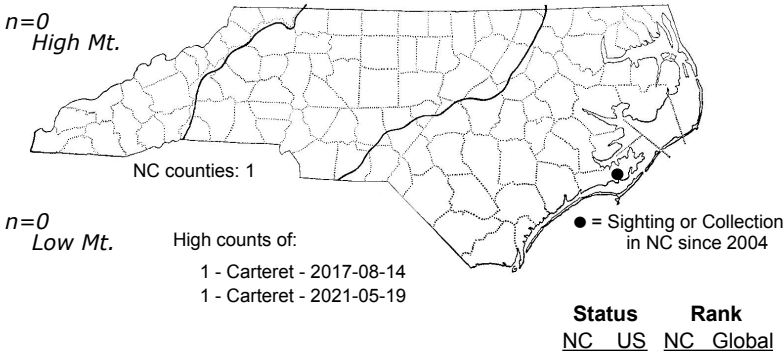
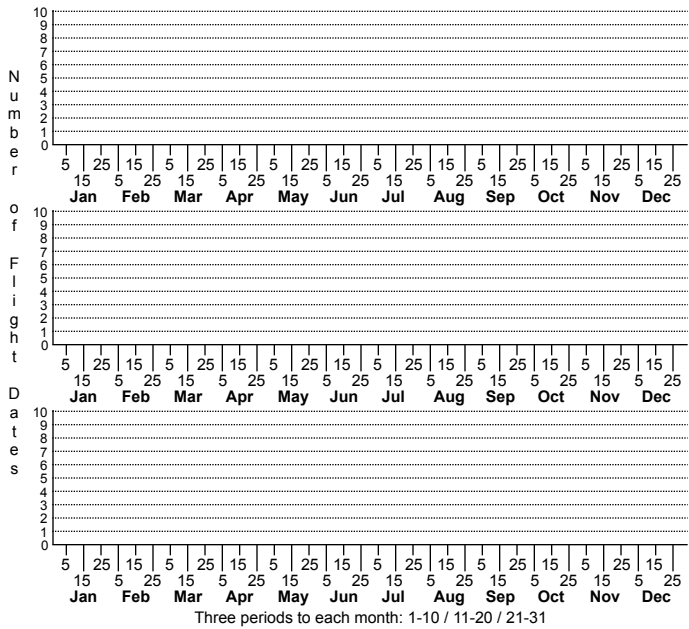

FOOD: Larvae bore into the root crowns and stems of several species of Composites, the following of which have been recorded in North Carolina: Late-flowering Thoroughwort (<i>Eupatorium serotinum</i>) and Common Ragweed (<i>Ambrosia artemisiifolia</i>) (Eichlin and Duckworth, 1988).
