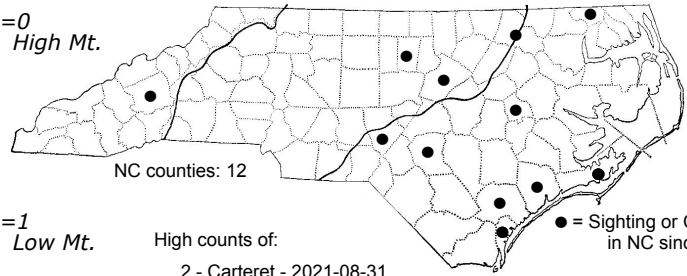
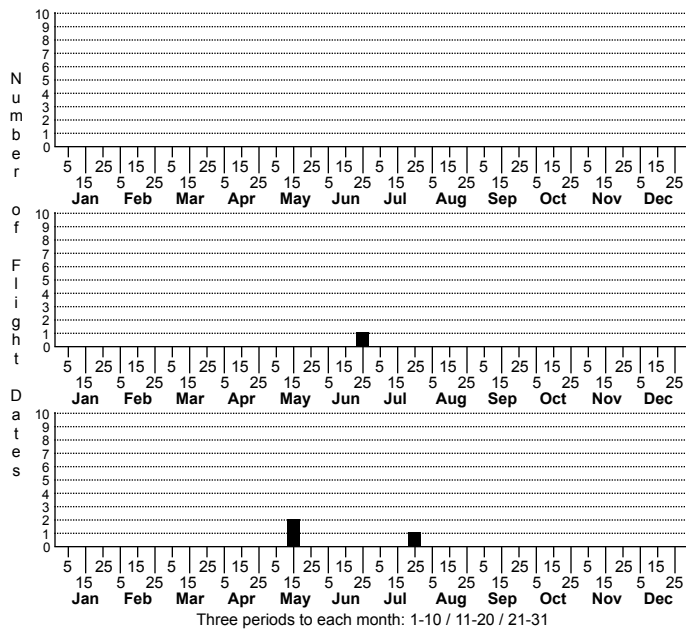


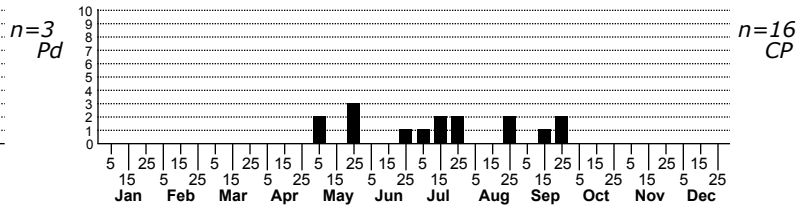
Atroposia oenotherana Primrose Cochylid Moth

FOOD: Host plants are poorly documented, but larvae are believed to feed on *Oenothera* species. There is a BugGuide record for a larva on Common Evening-primrose (*O. biennis*). We do not have any feeding records in North Carolina.
