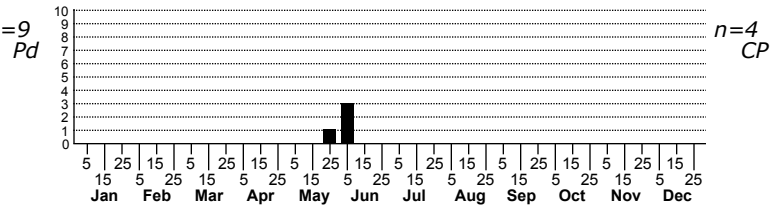
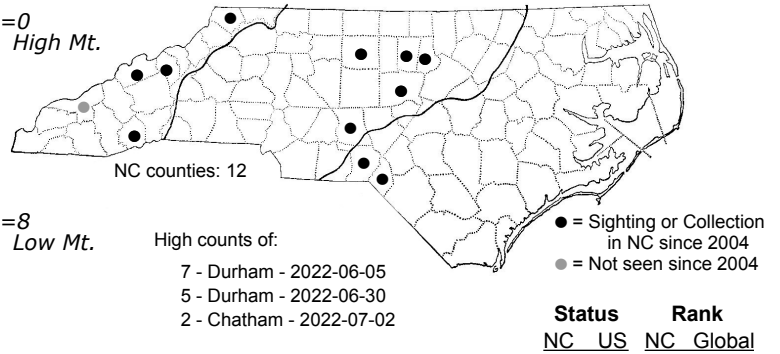
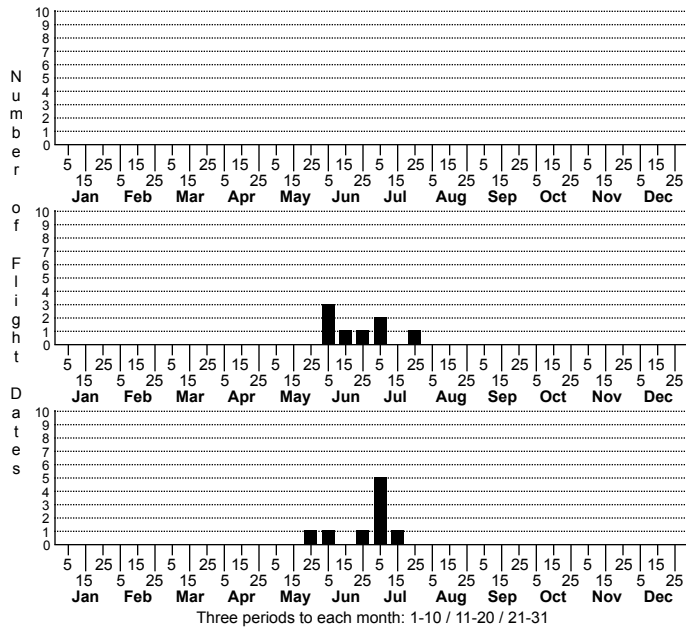


Haimbachia placidellus Peppered Haimbachia Moth
