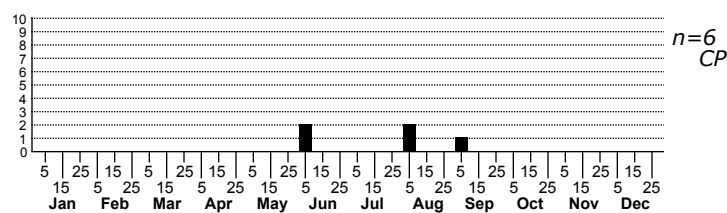
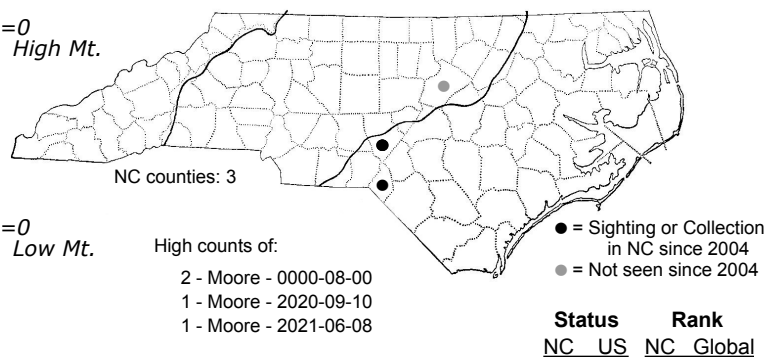
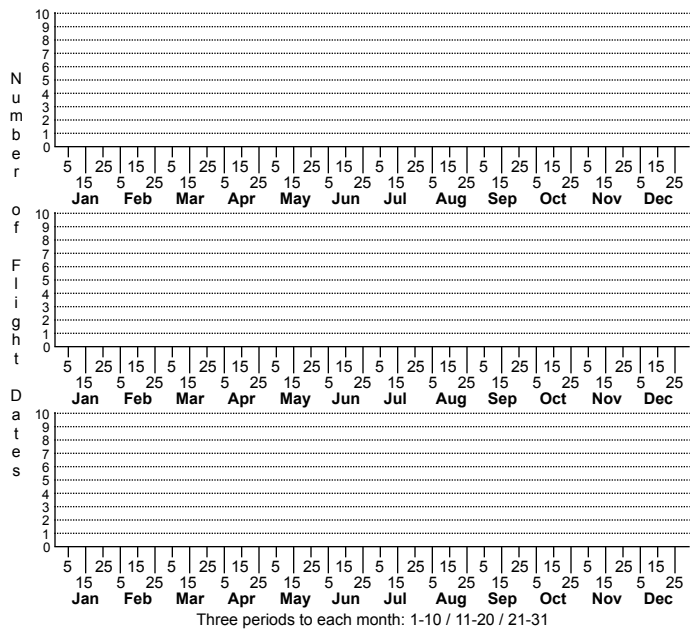


Penthesilea sacculalis No common name

FOOD: Larvae have been reported on Stachytarpheta jamaicensis (Robinson et al., 2010). That species, however, is a South American species that has not been recorded north of Florida along the Atlantic Coast (Weakley, 2015)

STATE PROTECTION: Has no legal protection, although permits are required to collect it on state parks and other public lands.
