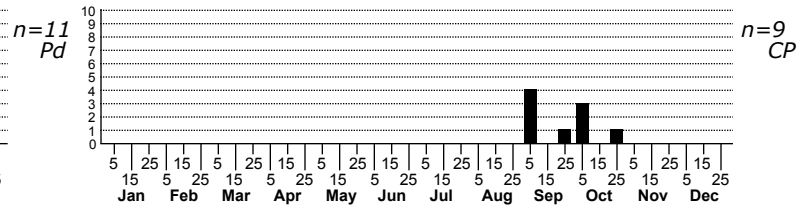
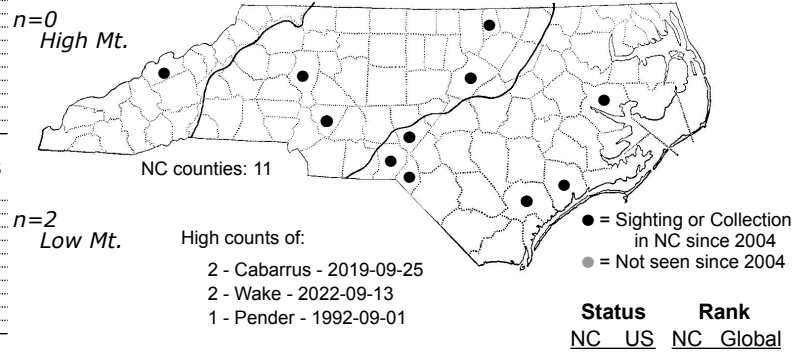
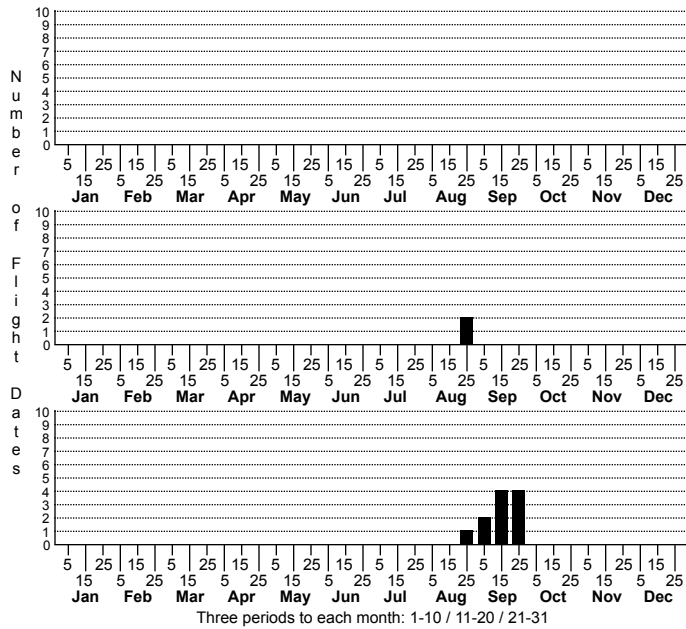

FOOD: Larvae feed on Loblolly (Robinson et al., 2010). Based on specimens collected in Madison County and confirmed by dissection, other pines must also be used since Loblollies are absent from the Mountains.
