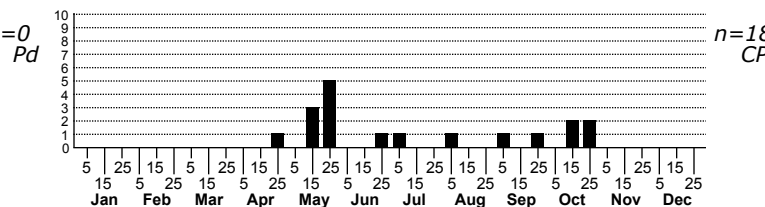
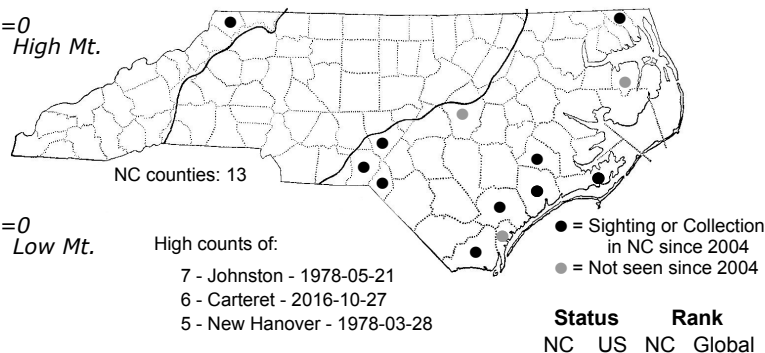
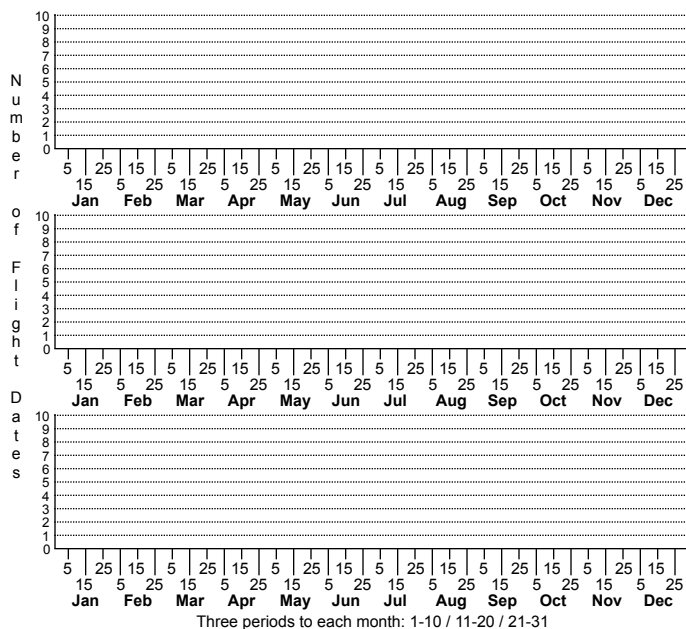


Caudellia apyrella Crescent-winged Caudellia Moth

HABITAT:

FOOD: Larvae feed on the seeds of Dodder (*Cuscuta* species); *Cuscuta compacta* and *C. gronovii* have both been documented as hosts in North Carolina (Corrette and Neunzig, 1979). Both of those species inhabit wetlands, including bottomland forests and open, herb-dominated habitats.
