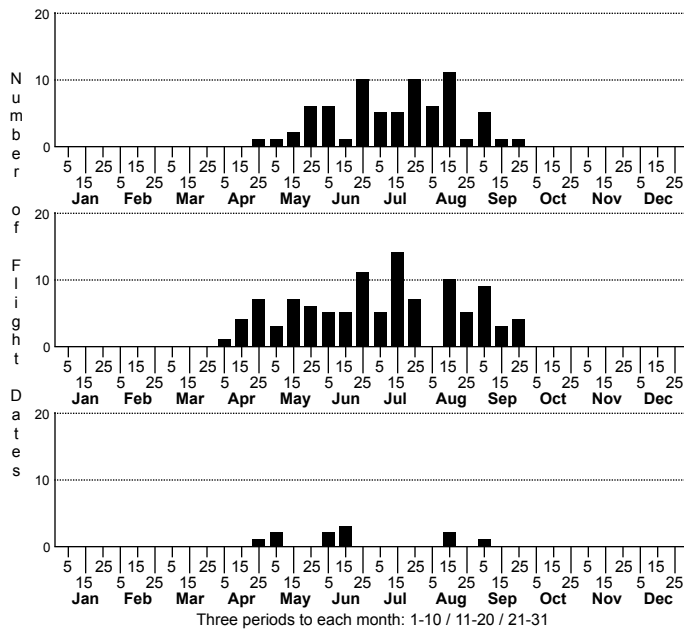


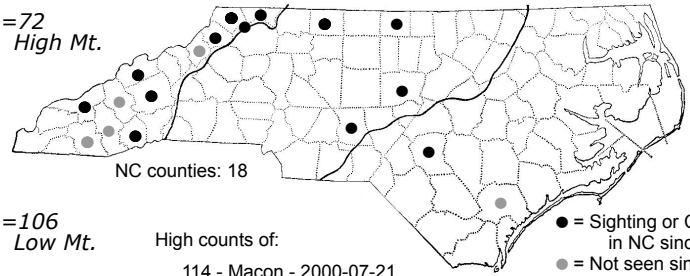
Cyclophora pendulinaria Sweetfern Geometer Moth

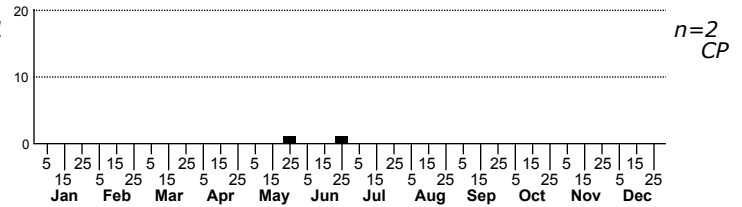
