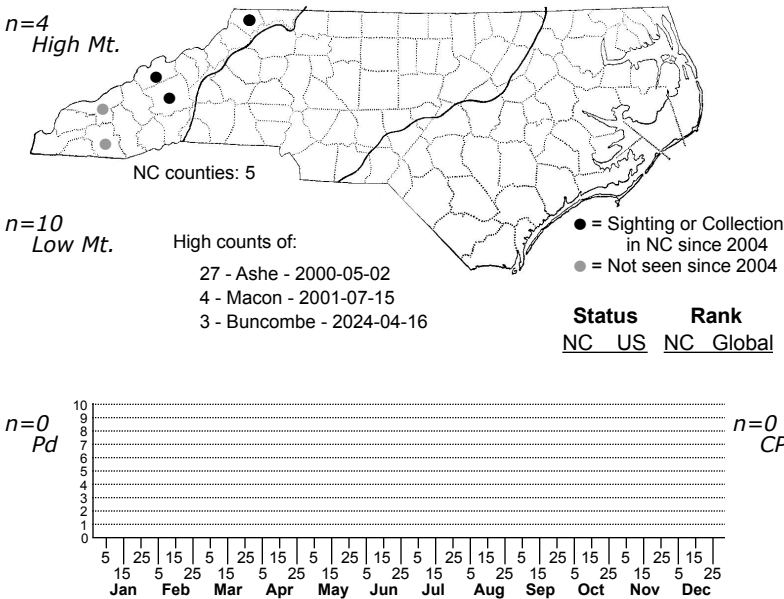
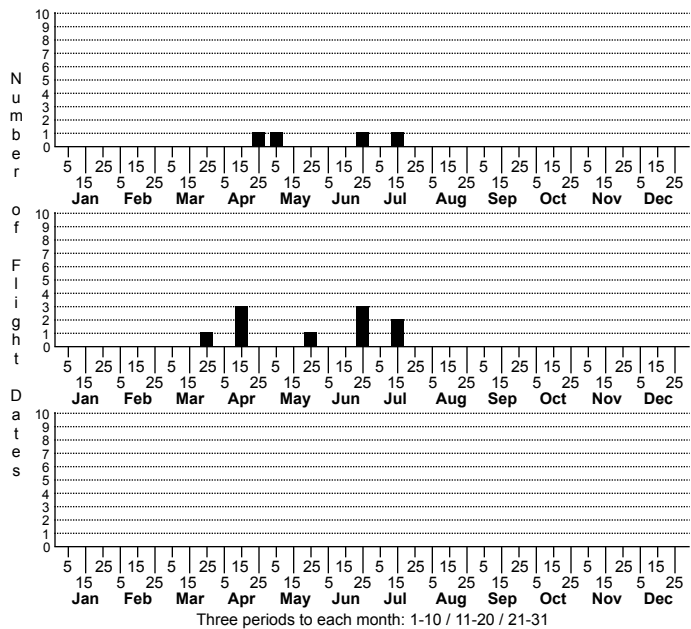


Venusia comptaria Brown-shaded Carpet Moth
