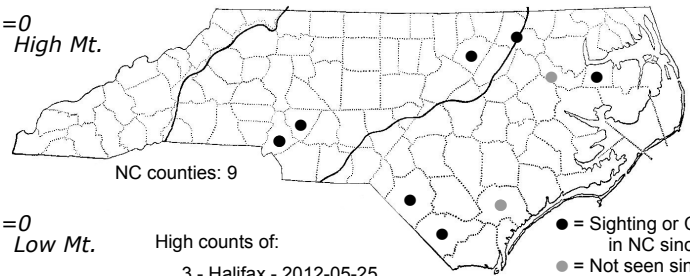
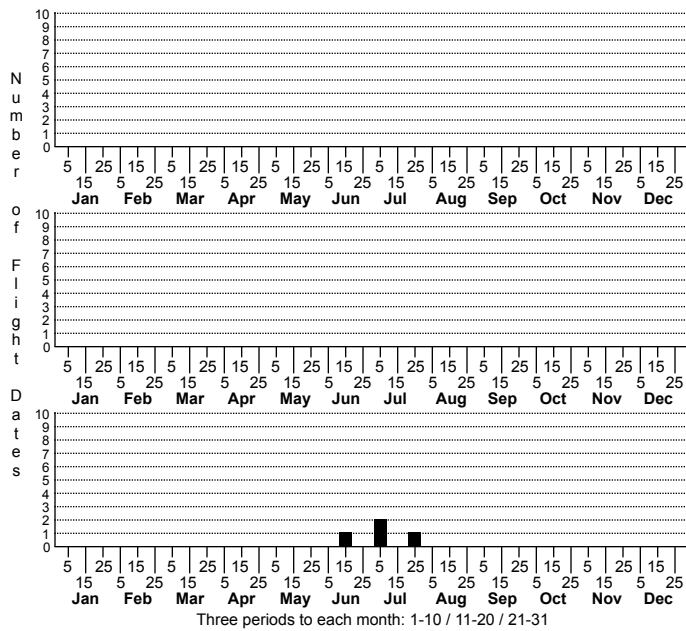


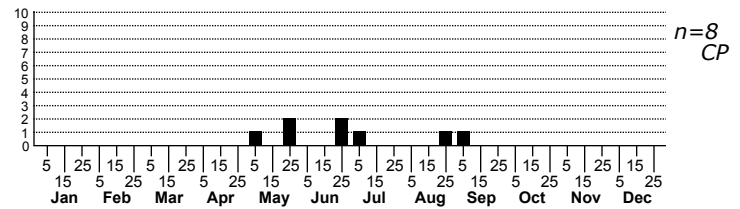
Melanomma auricinctaria Gold-lined Melanomma Moth
