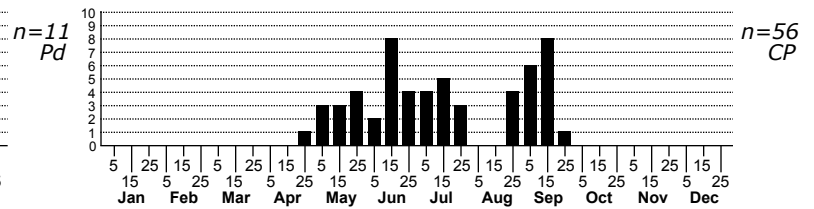
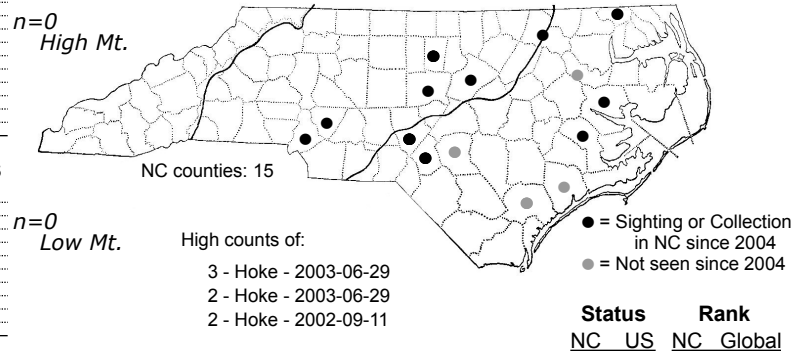
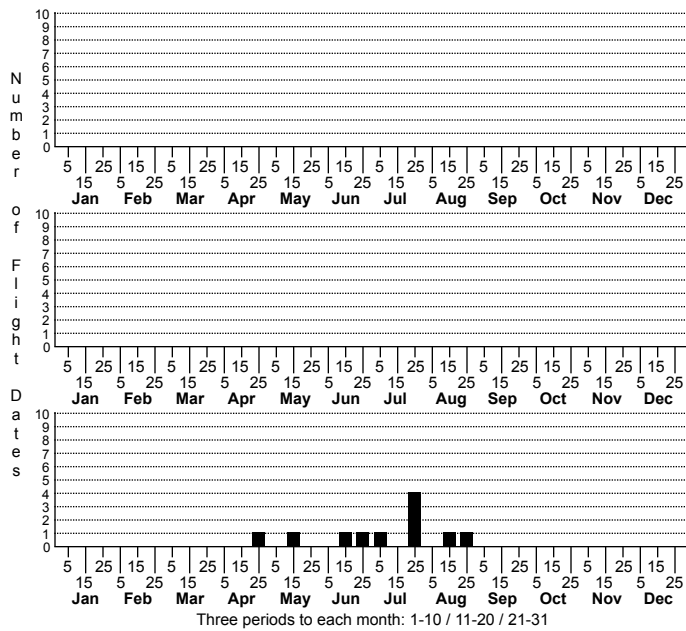


Emarginea percara Beloved Emarginea Moth
